Workshop of the Special Interest Group (SIG) in Healthcare Operations Management

The MSOM Society and the Special Interest Group (SIG) in Healthcare Operations Management invite researchers, clinicians, and healthcare executives to participate in an international workshop focused on research topics at the interface between healthcare and operations management. The workshop will be held at Columbia University on June 17, 2012, and will be followed by the MSOM annual conference.

The workshop will be focused on presenting collaborative work of scholars from the operations management community and clinicians and administrators from leading medical institutions. The program will consist of about six 45-minute presentations of papers that will be selected through a refereeing process, and up to two invited talks by senior healthcare executives. The selection of the papers will favor cutting-edge collaborative work between academics and clinicians/healthcare administrators with important methodological and practical impact. The presentations of the selected papers should target operations management audience as well as clinicians, healthcare executives and administrators.

Submissions should consist of a **10-page extended abstract** and a **single-page executive (non-technical) summary**. The executive summary should clearly state the nature of the results, paper's contributions and its potential practical impact.

Workshop will be co-chaired by Baris Ata (Kellogg School of Management) and Sergei Savin (The Wharton School). Submissions should be forwarded to homsig2012@wharton.upenn.edu. Please keep in mind the following key dates:
